

What is a WOW dollar?

A wow dollar is awarded when a student exhibits positive behavior. Its is part of a school-wide behavioral intervention approach. WOW dollars are distributed on a daily basis by all staff members. Students can earn WOW dollars for a variety of good behaviors, including followings class rules, walking quietly in the hallway being kind to others, etc.. The purpose of implement this type of system is to teach behavior expectations and to reward students for following them. Rather than waiting for misbehavior to occur, and then responding this positive approach is a way for staff to "Catch" students being good and to reward good behavior. Research has shown that the implementation of punishment, especially when it is used inconsistently and in the absence of positive strategies, is ineffective. Introducing, modeling, and reinforcing positive social behavior is an important part of a students educational experience.

FID

(Flexible Instruction Day)

It is that time of year again when we need to prepare for flexible Instruction days due to weather emergencies. It is expected that all students will attend asynchronously on FID unless technology/internet access is unavailable. Students are to follow the FID schedule below and complete the assignments posted in Google classroom. If technology is unavailable, students will be expected to complete the FID learning packet provided by their teacher.

Schedule for Flexible Instruction Days

10:30 All Students must be logged into Google Classroom to view the morning announcements and participate in asynchronous morning meetings/discussion boards.

10:45 - 12:00 Students work on assignments posted in Google Classroom or on FID packets issued by their teachers.

12:00 - 12:30 Lunch and Movement Break Snack and Movement Break

12:30 - 1:45 Students work on assignments posted in Google Classroom or on FID packets issued by their teachers.

1:45 -2:00 Snack and Movement Break

2:00 - 2:50 Students work on assignments posted in Google Classroom or on FID packets issued by their teachers.

FID Learning Packets and Attendance

Prior to a FID your teacher(s) will be sending five days worth of instruction home at the beginning of each month (Dec, Jan, Feb, March) in the event you are unable to attend school asynchronously via Google classroom on a FID. It is important that students do not complete FID packets prior to a FID and that the packet is available for students in the **event technology is unavailable.** When technology is unavailable, students must complete ALL assignments for each day at home to receive credit for attending that day.

Students will be marked absent until a written notification of their participation/attendance in FID and a COMPLETED packet is returned to school. It is due the first day following a FID. This is needed to verify their participation in the FID. If a student was absent on a FID they will be marked unexcused until GMCS receives proper excuses from parents or guardian.

GMCS Recess in Cold Weather

GMCS uses the following general guidelines for decision making related to recess:

- Regular outdoor recess will be held when outside air temperature and/or wind chill is 25° (F) or greater. The presence of rain or snowfall can influence this decision.
- Indoor recess will be held when outside air temperature and/or wind chill is lower than 25° (F).
- Whenever students are sent outside in cold temperatures, building staff watch for individual children who are not wearing appropriate clothing and may be at risk. In the event that a child does not have access to clothing necessary for cold temps or snow, GMCS is here to help! Just let us know
