Standardized Testing

What is it?

A **standardized test** is a test that is administered and scored in a consistent or "standard" manner. Standardized tests are designed in a way where the questions, conditions for administering, scoring procedures, and interpretations are consistent and are administered and scored in a predetermined, standard manner.
