

Important Reminders:

- Goodbyes in advance: Please say your goodbyes, hugs, and kisses while waiting in line-not once your vehicle has stopped in the drop-off zone.
- If there is a change in your student's transportation plans please call or email the office before 1:00pm with the change.
- Be ready: Your child should be unbuckled, backpack in hand, and ready to exit when you pull into the
 - Stay in line: Do not pull ahead of cars or buses unless a staff member directs you.
- Practice patience: A little extra time and grace go a long way for everyone.
- It is a rule of all transporting districts, that students are not allowed to ride the bus home with another student. Students may ride together as car riders if we have a note from both families stating such.















SCHOOL BUS SAFETY RULES:

- No eating or drinking on the bus.
- Stay in your seat and face forward, NEVER stand when the bus is in motion.
- Do not lean into the aisle. The aisle must stay clear.
- Keep your hands to yourself.
- Use whisper voices.
- Do not say inappropriate words or use inappropiate gestures.
- Use kind words.
- No vaping.
- No fighting.
- Do not throw anything on the bus.
- Do not litter or damage any property on the bus.
- Always listen and respect your bus driver.







Bus Conduct Consequences

The severity of the bus offense will determine the

appropriate sanction including potential suspension and/or loss of bus privileges.

1st offense: Verbal warning and parent notification

2nd offense: Lunch Detention and parent notification

3rd offense: 3-day bus suspension

4th offense: 4-day bus suspension

5th offense: 5-day bus suspension

6th offense: 10-day bus suspension

7th offense: 15-day bus suspension

8th offense: Loss of bus privileges for the remainder of the

school year



The goal of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act is to ensure that each homeless child or youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including a public preschool education, and extra-curricular activities, as provided to other children and youths. The Gettysburg Montessori Charter School will ensure that children and youth who are homeless are free from discrimination, segregation, and harassment. Any information regarding each student's homeless status shall be handled in a confidential and professional manner by school and system personnel.

Schedule for FID Days

- 10:30 AM Morning Announcements & Class Kickoff
- Students in 1st through 6th grade should log into Google Classroom at 10:30 AM to view the morning announcements and take part in their morning meeting.
- Afterward, teachers will share instructions for the day's assignments and activities.

Technology Support:

- If your child needs a hotspot for FID participation, please contact the office.

Reminders

- Students should not complete FID packets before a FID is announced.
- The packet must remain available in case technology is not accessible on a FID.
- If technology is unavailable, students are required to complete all assignments for each day at home in order to receive credit.

Attendance

- Students will be marked absent until the school receives:
- Written notification of their participation/attendance in the FID and
- The completed packet, returned on the first school day following the FID.
- If a student is absent during a FID, the absence will be recorded as unexcused unless GMCS receives a proper excuse from a parent/guardian.

Dental Physical Exam

Kindergarten and entering students: Physical Exams, Vaccinations Records and Dental Exams

3rd Grade: Dental Exam **6th Grade:** Physical Exam

All students entering the public school system are required by the state of Pennsylvania to have a physical exam, vaccination record (or exemption) and dental exam on file with the school.

In addition, all **3rd graders** are required to have an additional **dental exam** completed, with a form provided to the school.

Also, all **6th graders** are required to have a **physical exam**, with the form provided to the school.

Thank you so much to everyone who has turned these forms into the school. We know it's a busy time of year and appreciate your efforts! If you are still working on making appointments or picking up completed forms - thank you! It's not too late. These forms are still needed for the 2025-2026 school year.

The forms are available on the GMCS website or can be picked up from the school. If you have any questions or can provide the date of an upcoming appointment when forms will be completed, please call the school nurse at 717-334-1120.

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Our Family First Health Mobile Dental Team will visit your child's school during the school day to provide dental care. The school will have information on the exact dates we'll be there. After each visit, we'll send a paper home with your child that explains what we did and if more care is needed.

Dental problems are one of the main reason kids miss school. This program helps kids get dental care without missing much of their school day. The school works with Family First Health Mobile Dental Program to plan the day so it's easy for everyone. We will bill your insurance if you have it. If not, we may be able to help you find coverage. Students enrolled in the program will get the following care, as needed: dental exam(s), X-rays, dental cleaning(s), fluoride treatments, protective sealants, and oral health education.

For your child to participate in the 2025-2026 program year, you must complete a separate enrollment form for each child. You can do so easily online with a smart phone, tablet, or computer. Forms must be submitted in advance of the first visit to your child's school.
